2006 Patriarche Viognier, Vin de Pays (Languedoc, France)	£4.00	£5.00	£12.50
<i>Aromatic, spicy, apricot notes, with an attractive softness on the palate</i>			
2006 Los Olas Torrontes (Argentina)			£13.50
<i>This unique varietal, almost exclusively grown in Argentina, produces an elegant, crisp wine showing hints of citrus fruits. It is well balanced with crispness, acidity and a long, refreshing finish.</i>

<i>The strong bright passion fruit aroma is complimented with traces of vanilla and oak. The palate shows full peach and melon fruit flavours, good length and weight and a clean crisp finish.</i>

<i>Melon and fresh citrus are underscored with a delicate honeysuckle perfume. The flavours are a blend of sweet grapefruit and lemon zest with a hint of honeydew.</i>

<i>Inviting fresh citrus and tropical fruit flavours overlay mineral characters. Balanced structure with racy acidity, good texture a concentrated mid-palate and a crisp finish.</i>			
2005 Hahn Estate Chardonnay (California)			£24.00
<i>Decidedly tropical nose with hints of apricot and butterscotch. Ripe core of peach and pineapple flavours turn to green apple towards the back of the mouth. Sur-lie ageing provides a rich clean mouth-feel from inception to finish.</i>			
2005 Chateau de Marsannay, Marsannay (Burgundy, France)			£30.00
<i>Decidedly tropical nose with hints of apricot and butterscotch. Ripe core of peach and pineapple flavours turn to green apple towards the back of the mouth. Sur-lie ageing provides a rich clean mouth-feel from inception to finish.</i>

2001 Meursault Premier Cru, Domaine du Chateau De Meursault (Burgundy) £80.00

This wine is straw-gold in colour with hints of toasty mature fruits and buttery aromas on the nose. The full-bodied palate is creamy and well rounded and the wine has a long finish.

Rose Wine

2006 Patriarche Pinot Noir Rose, Vin De Pays (Languedoc, France) £4.00 £5.00 £12.50

Fresh and fruity with flavours of cherries and raspberries and a crisp clean finish.

2006 Cycles gladiator Rose (California) £17.50

This is a Grenache-based Rosé with pretty aromatics of strawberry and guava. Bright flavours of red fruits and peach that finish with subtle yet mouthwatering acidity, especially with spicy food.

Red Wine

2006 Patriarche Merlot, Vin De Pays (Languedoc, France) £4.00 £5.00 £12.50

Deeply coloured with complex notes of ripe blackberries, a rich and full-bodied palate and a long mouth-filing finish

2006 Los Olas Torrontes (Argentina) £4.00 £5.00 £13.50

This wine has an intense red colour with bright violet tones, a complex bouquet of ripe plum and black cherry aromas with a hint of spice and a well rounded palate with good acidity.

2005 Cantaluna Menguante Cabernet Sauvignon Carmenere (Chile) £14.00

Deep purple red in colour, Cantaluna Menguante Cabernet Sauvignon Carmenère is a soft and full-bodied blend with hints of spicy red fruit and a warm, velvety finish.

2003 Heath Wines Shiraz (Australia) £4.50 £5.50 £15.00

The palate is medium to full-bodied with full flavours of berry fruits and dark chocolate, supported by subtle oak and grainy but soft tannins with a nice clean finish.

2006 Mount Riley Pinot Noir (New Zealand) £20.00

Inviting fresh citrus and tropical fruit flavours overlay mineral characters. Balanced structure with racy acidity, good texture a concentrated mid-palate and a crisp finish.

Red Wine (Continued)

2004 Domaine Catherine Le Goeuil, Cairanne £24.00
Cuvee Lea Felsch (Rhone, France)

A clear, dark reddish-purple wine with an appealing nose of floral fruit and hints of "earthiness", the palate is full of rich red berry flavours, good acidity and gentle tannins. This is a lovely wine with great balance and a long finish.

2005 Hahn Syrah (California) £26.00

Hints of pepper and floral notes on the nose combine with more prominent tones of blackberry and spice. Plum, cherry and dark chocolate on the palate with rounded silky tannins and good acidity.

2002 Chateau Garraud Lalande de Pomerol (Bordeaux, France) £35.00

Toast and vanilla dominate the nose with fresh fruit aromas. The palate has great texture and no harshness thanks to the lush tannins. The finish is persistent and unctuous

2001 Rioja Reserva Ermita de San Felices (Spain) £40.00

Deep black colour with red brim. Its beautiful and bright colour as well as its powerful bouquet show the quality of the grapes used. The ageing in barriques gives its spicy and balsamic aromas adding complexity. This Rioja Reserva is a well balanced and full bodied wine with a wonderful aftertaste.

2004 Chateauneuf du Pape (Rhone Valley, France) £45.00

Deep black colour with red brim. Its beautiful and bright colour as well as its powerful bouquet show the quality of the grapes used. The ageing in barriques gives its spicy and balsamic aromas adding complexity. This Rioja Reserva is a well balanced and full bodied wine with a wonderful aftertaste.

Dessert Wine

1999 Chateau Septy Monbazillac (France) £15.00 (Bottle)

Zesty, sweet but not cloying, good acidity, melon and pineapple dominate on the palate with overtones of roasted fruit and good persistence.
